The use is always to be consistent with Catholic teaching, doctrine, morality and values. Holy Family School cannot be responsible for guaranteeing the content retrieved on the Internet. While our staff will be directing the classroom activities, the teachers cannot attend to each individual student 100% of the time he/she might be using the Internet.
