From Fr. Alex, our Pastor...

This will be my first written communication to the members of Holy Family Parish and I will continue to do it on a regular basis. My contact email will be algabri567@gmail.com

I moved into the parish on Wednesday, June 29th in the afternoon. I was welcomed by a crew of a half dozen men led by Jamie Hoover. They got to work and unloaded my bags and baggage and I certainly appreciate their timely services.

Installation: On Sunday, July 3rd at 10:00 am Mass, I was officially installed as Pastor of both Holy Family and St. Joseph parishes by Fr. Greg Oligschlaeger, the Dean of the Central Deanery. I was installed in a wonderful service in a meaningful way by Fr. Greg. The staff members of both parishes, their Pastoral Council and Finance Council members were asked to assist the Pastor in carrying out his ministries. I am thankful for the presence of the Pastoral Council and Finance Councils and the staff of each parish as I begin my ministry at Holy Family, Hannibal and St. Joseph, Palmyra. I look forward to meeting and serving the parishioners of both churches.

A New Motto: At the Masses at my installation I also announced that **JOY** will be the motto of both parishes.

J stands for Jesus, **O** stands for others, **Y** stands for yourself. In the order of the letters **J** comes first, that is **JESUS** first, **O** comes next, that is others next and **Y** comes last, that is yourself last. We will be joyful when Jesus has the first place in our lives.

Change in weekday Mass time: To make it more convenient for everyone, the weekday Mass times will all be at **8:15 am**. Those who weighed in on the decision agreed this would be the best time.

Some Regulations: This past weekend, for good and spiritual growth of the parish family some regulations were announced. **1.** The Rosary at the weekend Masses will end 5 minutes before Mass begins and the musicians can play an interlude until the start of the entrance procession. **2.** The bulletins will be handed out after Mass with the intention of keeping the mind focused on the Liturgy that is going to be celebrated. The greeters will take care of passing the bulletins out after Mass. The entire focus is to have a Jesus experience in the church before, during and after Mass. **3.** All socialization before and after Mass will take place in the gather space at the back of the church to keep the sanctity of the church. It is a good space to stay around and say "Hi" to friends and family.

Feedback: I am getting both positive and negative feedback on the new regulations that I announced at the Masses this past weekend, which I appreciate. The sole intention was to begin a process of creating a prayerful atmosphere in the church for a Jesus experience. We want our parish to be a Jesus-centered parish with the cooperation of everyone. It may be hard to embrace the changes at first, but eventually you will realize the value of placing the focus on the liturgy from beginning to end.

I would not like to be compared to my predecessors. They did amazing jobs in their own way. My style of functioning will be different. Each Pastor brings something new into the life of the parish using God-given talents.

Transparency: I would like to promote transparency at all levels by printing the minutes of the different councils and committee meetings along with a monthly financial statement in our bulletin. God had a plan for both parishes by sending me here. I am trying to discern His will as I move on with my ministries here. Our church is dynamic by its very nature, changes are a part of this process. I hope and pray that you will take the changes in the right spirit and come forward to work together to build up a Christ-centered parish following the Stewardship way.

A concern: We are blessed to have a wonderful school with great facilities and dedicated faculty and staff. I have learned that the numbers are small in Pre-K and Kindergarten. This is not encouraging as small numbers in lower grades will eventually have an effect. Our parish is blessed to have many children and they have the right to get a good education in the Catholic School. Education in the Catholic School will give a good foundation as the children move to public school and on to life. If parents have any concerns, they may contact me directly.

Ministry needs: We are looking for some dedicated persons (paid or non-paid positions) who will coordinate Religious Education and Youth Ministry. It could be teamwork, consisting of one to look after Religious Education, another Confirmation, another for RCIA. Perhaps a couple to take care of Youth Ministry. I am looking forward to having some dedicated persons to run these God-given ministries for the good and growth of our parish. Please pass the word around or persuade someone whom you think would be good for these ministries to contact me.

Church Pews: You all are well aware of the squeaky noise that comes out when sitting on the pews which is quite disturbing. I would appreciate if anyone in the parish has some expertise in fixing it to contact me.

Live Streaming Sunday 10am Mass: It has been reported that the livestream was set up during the pandemic. Now that the pandemic is over, it could be easily stopped. I was also told there are only 23 homebound people watching it. They could be helped to tune in to EWTN, Channel 100 on Spectrum, which has Holy Mass, rosaries and other devotions at different times during the day. Before I finalize it, I would like to have feedback from those watching the 10:00 am livestream Mass.

Money Counting Safety:

Following the regulations of the Diocese and the recommendation by auditors, Renee Fisher is getting a deposit box facility to drop the weekend collections in the bank after each Mass. For this, I would like to have the service of the money counters and members of the Finance Council taking turns making the drop at the bank.

“Our families need to ask for the gift of the Spirit! Through prayer, even in the busiest times, we give time back to God, we find the peace that comes from appreciating the important things, and we encounter the joy of God’s unexpected gifts. Through daily prayer may our homes become, like the house of Martha and Mary, places where Jesus always finds a warm welcome (Pope Francis).” While it is necessary to attend to the details of hospitality, learning how to be present to people, experiences, and God is sometimes more important.
