



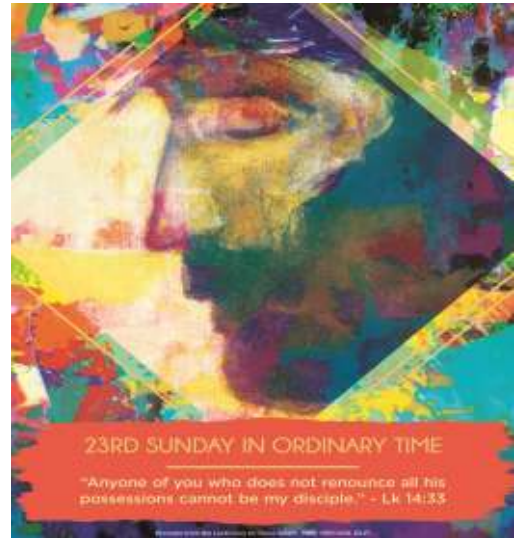

**From the Pastor:**

**Eucharistic Adoration:** I would like to encourage and promote Eucharistic Adoration in our Parish. We are truly blessed to have a Perpetual Adoration going on in our Church and it is indeed a blessing. I am really edified by the people who show up to do the adoration on a regular basis which is a sign of God's special grace coming down upon them and the Parish. Still there are hours uncovered **on Saturday 1 – 3 pm and 5 pm to 3 am on Sunday, Sunday 8 – 10 am and 12 – 2 pm.** Through the Words of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary, "I have a burning thirst to be honored by men in the Blessed Sacrament, and I find hardly anyone who strives, according to My desire, to allay this thirst by making Me some return of love, "I invite all those who have not given an hour to the Lord to quench His thirst. Terra Murphy is working on getting an electronic locking system fixed on the door with a code facility to enter which will hopefully eliminate undue hassles.

Our School children are doing Adoration class-wise in the main church on First Fridays from 9 am – 12:30 pm to be concluded with Benediction.

**Inspiring Thoughts on Eucharistic Adoration:** "The holy hour in our modern rat race is necessary for authentic prayer. Our world is one of speed in which intensity of movement is a substitute for lack of purpose; where noise is invoked to drown out the whisperings of conscience; where talk, talk, talk gives the impression that we are doing something when really we are not; where activity kills self-knowledge won by contemplation...

There seems to be so little in common between our involvement with the news of the world and the Stranger in whose Presence we find ourselves. The hour means giving up a golf game or a cocktail party, or a nap...

Sometimes it is hard, especially during vacation when we have nothing to do. I remember once having two hours between trains in Paris. I went to the Church of Saint Roch to make my holy hour. There are not ten days a year I can sleep in the daytime. This was one. I was so tired, I sat down at 2:00p.m.--too tired to kneel--and went to sleep. I slept perfectly until 3:00p.m. I said to the Good Lord: "Did I make a holy hour?" The answer came back: "Yes! That's the way the Apostles made their first one." The best time to make a holy hour is in the morning, early, before the day sets traps for us. By being faithful to it, and letting nothing interfere with it, we use it as the sign and symbol of our victimhood. We are not called to great penances, and many would interfere with our duty, but the hour is our daily sacrifice in union with Christ." (Venerable Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen)

**Change of Weekend Mass Times:** Perhaps most of you have been taken by surprise with the changes at the weekend Mass times. I was informed that both the former Pastor and the Senior Priest in Residence at Palmyra already talked about changing the weekend Mass times in such a way when one of them will be out of town or on vacation, the other will be able to cover the Masses at both the places. These proposed changes were discussed at the Pastoral council.

In agreement with the PC of Palmyra, Holy Family is going to have the Saturday Mass at 4 pm and Sunday Masses at 7:30 am and 11 am while St. Joseph, Palmyra will have only two Masses - one on Saturday (5:30 pm) and one on Sunday (9:30 am). I hope that you will take these changes in good spirit within the context of priests' shortage in the diocese. Now the ball is in your court to fill in the pews as the weekend Mass counts are sent to the diocese on every month started in August. If the attendance shows a declining curve in a year, we will also be left with two Masses one on Saturday and one on Sunday. Confession will be held on Saturdays from 3 – 3:45 pm. The PSR and RCIA classes will be held on Sundays from 9:30 am to 10:45 am to be able to attend the 11 am Mass.

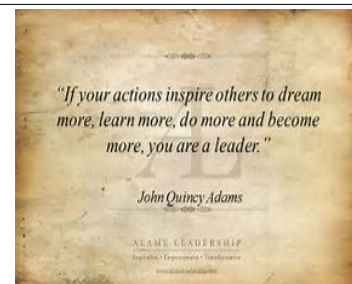


**VOLUNTEER HELP NEEDED...**
