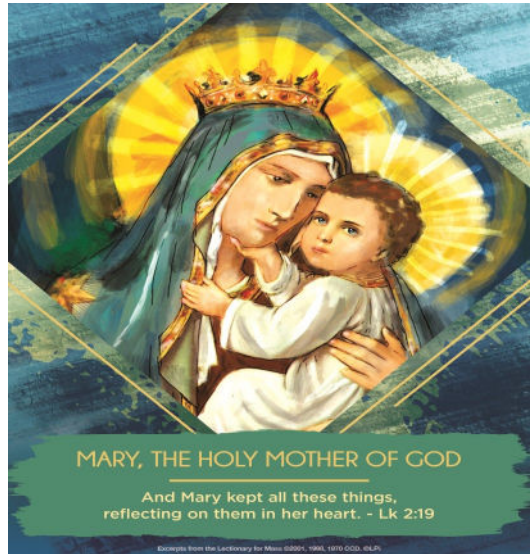

**Feast of the Holy Mother of God:** It is a wonderful way of stepping into the New Year 2023 by celebrating the Feast of Mary being the Mother of God obtaining abundance of blessings for us, our families, country, and the world. It is worthwhile reading the summary of what Pope Francis said on the feast as following: At the start of the new year, having a devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary isn't just something that is nice or good to do, but is an obligation in the life of a Christian. "Devotion to Mary is not spiritual etiquette; it is a requirement of the Christian life," the Pope said Jan. 1. "The gift of the Mother, the gift of every mother and every woman, is most precious for the Church, for she too is mother and woman."



"If our faith is not to be reduced merely to an idea or a doctrine, all of us need a mother's heart, one which knows how to keep the tender love of God and to feel the heartbeat of all around us."

Pope Francis noted that as we start a new year, it is a good time for Christians to also start anew, leaving behind past burdens and baggage and starting over from what really matters. And "today," the Pope said, "we have before us the point of departure: The Mother of God."

"For Mary is exactly what God wants us to be, what he wants his Church to be: A Mother who is tender and lowly, poor in material goods and rich in love, free of sin and united to Jesus, keeping God in our hearts and our neighbor in our lives."

"Today's feast tells us that if we want to go forward, we need to turn back: to begin anew from the crib, from the Mother who holds God in her arms," he stated (Vatican City, Jan 1, 2018 / 03:55 am (EWTN))

**7 Ups for the New Year:** It is interesting to read and practice the 7 Ups as the new year resolution:

- 1) **WAKE UP**—Begin the day thanking the Lord. It is His day. Rejoice in it.
- 2) **LOOK-UP**—Open your eyes to the Lord Jesus. Ask for his strength and blessings for the day through the anointing of his Holy Spirit. After all, he is your only Savior.
- 3) **DRESS-UP**—Put on a smile. It improves your looks. It says something about your attitude. It enables Jesus living within you smile at others.
- 4) **SHUT-UP**—Watch your tongue. Don't gossip. Don't be judgmental. Say nice things. Learn to listen to others with love. Be sympathetic.
- 5) **STAND-UP**—Take a stand for what you believe. Resist evil. Do good. Have the courage of your Christian convictions by practicing what you believe.
- 6) **REACH-UP**—Spend time in prayer by talking to God with your adorations, confessions, thanksgivings and supplications and by listening to Him through attentive reading the Bible and the application of its message to your life.
- 7) **LIFT-UP**—Be available to help those in need—serving, supporting, and sharing. Try to find Jesus in others and serve him there by serving them. (Adapted from Rev. Walter Schoedel)

Today's readings include another account of the story of Jesus' birth. Numbers reminds us that we are blessed. We are looked upon with kindness and grace. The psalm and Galatians remind us of the blessings given through God's Son. Luke tells of our ultimate blessing, that Mary, a human being like us, gave birth to a child who is God's Son. Mary, a young mother, watches all that is happening around the birth of her son. She listens as the shepherds bring messages from angels, a message she also received from an angel, about her son. Yet Mary remains silent. She keeps all this news about her son to herself. She reflects on all these experiences. The only thing she shares is the name of her son, Jesus, a name given him before he was even conceived. Her silence leaves us wondering if this is how one responds to such a great blessing.

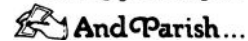
