**President Report:**

- Mission review of how the school curriculum this past year lined up with the mission, from QRP to mental health program, internet and body safety. Focus will be on the emotional aspect as we move forward.
- Self-Study goals, this was year 3. A report goes to MO nonpublic accreditation association. We will work on these objectives next year:
  - Establish a vision among leadership team - share vision across boards, committees, the parish. Increase awareness and get information out.
  - Routine time for collaboration between pastor and principal
  - Establish mental and emotional health
  - Support all students - title 1 extended day program and Leap Programs continued.
- Heating and Electric upgrades started.
- Enrollment at 124 (123 this past year).
- Hired full time housekeeper for parish and school.
- Tech Support Person hired part-time. First goal is to tackle things in the parish. Hardware and software focus, while Mrs. Hooley and Mrs. Millan taking care of day-to-day things in the school.
- Reidal grant being worked on by Mrs. Hooley to upgrade laptops and other hardware. Hoping to get \$6K from this grant.
- Finance Council will share details at August 23/24 masses.
- Budget for next year being prepared next week by finance council.
  - School is largest part of the budget and giving is going down.

**Pastors Report:**

- Totus Tuus going on this week, ~40 kids day program and ~15 for evening program.
- New accounting system - version of QuickBooks for all parishes. Training will be happening in next few weeks.
- Mass times are moving to 8 and 10 a.m. rather than 7:30 and 11 a.m. Starts July 13.
